

Site Admin Guide to using Coursework

Install the mod/coursework plugin on your Moodle site.

You will be able to change defaults in Site Administration > Plugins > Activity > Coursework

Configuring the Turnitin integration for Coursework

Step 1: Install Turnitin V2 and the Plagiarism Plugin version 2017022201 or higher from:

Step 2: Configure the Turnitin V2 plugin with your Turnitin account details (Site Administration > Plugins > Activity Modules > Turnitin Assignment 2)

Step 3: Go to Site Administration > Advanced Features and enable the 'Enable Plagiarism plugins' option

Step 4: Enable the Turnitin Plagiarism Plugin for Coursework by going to Site Administration > Plugins > Plagiarism > Turnitin Plagiarism Plugin
